ENTREPRENEURSHIP

- **TopDropIndia, Founder, Head of Sourcing and Marketing:** Popular shoes and clothes nowadays are hard to find as they are sold out almost minutes after they are launched, recognizing the demand for these shoes and clothes i founded a business through which i sourced shoes and clothes in demand from around the world while earning profits. Sourced 70-80 items of clothing in a 3-4 month long span earning approximately 5000-10000 profit per item.
- **Ethication - Ethical Fashion, Founder:** Recognising the wasteful nature of uniforms made for factory workers. I founded a brand, Ethication, sourcing t-shirts from Tirupur made from 100% recycled cotton. Targeting five factories, I sold 500 tshirts for workers utilising the wasted cotton from the production process.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- **Founder, The Aasha Foundation (www.theaashafoundation.org):** As i witnessed the onslaught brought on by COVID 19 I discerned the lack of communication between those offering aid and those affected. Thus I founded a non profit organisation in order to tackle this. Through this organisation I strived to have a sizeable impact on the COVID affected landscape of my country. As the country was faced a shortage in oxygen cylinders, i set about sourcing oxygen cylinders and rare medications for COVID patients in quarantine. I

organised a vaccine camp where we got 150 factory workers vaccinated against the virus as that is the only effective way to fight it. In collaboration with Samarpan Foundation, I organised a fundraiser in order to provide bio degradable reusable sanitary pads for the menstrual health of underprivileged women who lost their jobs due to COVID 19, raising 100000INR.

- **FestiVista, Organiser:** Wanting to improve the conditions in a local orphanage, I organised a winter fair where various stalls selling cosmetics, clothes and food; Raised 60000 INR for Nani Pari charity.
- **Activities Towards Sustainable Development:** Sustainable development goals address major problems plaguing the world. I chose to work against World Hunger, Child Labour and towards a Sustainable Future. I educated farmers in rural areas about techniques for sustainable development and farming. Travelling from village to village I conversed with farmers explaining the benefits of sustainable soil as well as the harmful effects of stubble burning and providing them with alternatives like bio decomposers. In addition to that I educated under privileged children with the Hartron Skill Centre. Over a two month long time period I educated underprivileged children on how to utilise Python and Java, providing them with a comprehensive understanding of both.

LEADERSHIP

- **Agni House Captain (2021-22):** After a hard fought election, I was elected as the House Captain for the term 2021-22. Tasked with leading my house to victory in the Inter House Trophy, I worked hard to inculcate a sense of house spirit and discipline amongst my house members. Under my leadership Agni House saw the highest participation out of all the houses and we finished runner's up in the Inter House Trophy, the highest we had ever placed.
- **Dance Club, Secretary:** Choreographed dances for students from Grade 9 and above, organised two flash mobs to raise awareness about mental health. Helped students with mental health by helping them find an outlet to express emotions via dance.
